**Mr. Anil Saxena**, has devoted more than 26 years of his life to serving poor and helpless patients at Safdarjung Hospital. Since the year 2000, he has been tirelessly working as a social worker, standing beside those who arrive at the hospital with not only severe illnesses but also financial hardship, loneliness, and emotional distress.



Over the years, he has become a source of hope for thousands of underprivileged patients and families who struggle to navigate the complexities of medical treatment in a large government hospital. Currently serving as a Coordinator with **Krishnavi Charitable Trust** at Safdarjung Hospital, Anil Saxena works closely with the Medical Welfare Department and under the guidance of welfare officers to identify and assist financially vulnerable patients in need of urgent support.

His responsibilities include helping poor patients consult doctors, ensuring timely OPD follow-ups, arranging blood tests and other medical investigations, and guiding families through the treatment process. Many patients arriving at the hospital are physically weak, injured, elderly, or unable to move independently. For such patients, he arranges wheelchairs, bicycles, suction machines, air mattresses, commode chairs, orthopaedic aids, and other essential medical support items required for their recovery and comfort.

Beyond medical assistance, his work reflects deep human care. He regularly visits hospital wards to look after unattended and unknown patients who have no family support. He helps arrange food, drinking water, medicines, and basic necessities for those who are abandoned or financially helpless.

At the Dharamshala near Safdarjung Hospital, where many poor patients and attendants stay during long-term treatment, he actively supports families by arranging meals, milk, medicines, orthopaedic aids, and other essential items. For many families coming from distant villages and small towns, this support becomes their only source of survival during treatment.

He also coordinates with doctors, charitable organizations, and donors to ensure that poor patients receive proper medical care without interruption. Whether it involves arranging treatment support, medicines, surgeries, diagnostic tests, or daily living essentials, he continuously works to bridge the gap between patients' needs and available resources.

For more than two decades, **Anil Saxena** has quietly dedicated himself to the service of humanity — helping countless patients who arrive at Safdarjung Hospital with fear and uncertainty, and giving them not only medical support but also dignity, compassion, and hope.
