

## When Poverty Meets Illness: Naved's Fight for Life

**A Humanitarian Story by Krishnavi Charitable Trust**



At just 13 years of age, Naved should have been spending his days in school, playing with friends, and dreaming about his future. Instead, this young boy from Meerut has been fighting a painful and life-threatening liver disease that has turned his childhood into a struggle for survival.

For nearly two years, Naved's family moved from one hospital to another across Uttar Pradesh, desperately searching for treatment that could save their son. Every visit brought new medicines, new tests, and new expenses — but no relief. As his condition continued to worsen, hope slowly began fading from the family's life.

Naved's father, the only earning member of the family, works as a daily wage labourer with masons at construction sites. Whatever little he earns is barely enough to feed the family. Yet, like every father, he refused to give up on his child. With tears in his eyes and hope in his heart, he brought Naved to Safdarjung Hospital, Delhi where the child was admitted to Ward No. 20 on 11 April 2026.

During treatment, Dr. Meena understood the painful reality of the family's financial condition and connected them with **Krishnavi Charitable Trust**. At a time when the family had almost no resources left, they were informed that one of the injections required for Naved's treatment would cost nearly ₹44,000. For a family struggling even for daily meals, this amount felt impossible.

But humanity still exists where compassion leads the way.

Recognizing the urgency of the child's condition, **Krishnavi Charitable Trust** stepped forward to support Naved's treatment and stand beside the family in their darkest hours. The Trust's team regularly visits the hospital, monitors his condition, guides the family through medical procedures,



and provides every possible support to ensure that poverty does not become a reason for a child losing his life.

Naved is still admitted and continues to fight bravely every single day. His weak body carries the pain of illness, but his eyes still carry hope — hope to recover, to return home, and to live a normal childhood again.

This is not just the story of one child. It is the reality faced by countless families who silently suffer between illness and poverty. Naved's journey reminds us that timely medical care, compassion, and collective support can become the difference between despair and hope.

Through every hospital visit, every medicine arranged, and every hand held in support, Krishnavi Charitable Trust continues its mission of standing beside vulnerable patients and ensuring that no child is left alone in the fight for life.
